Firefighter of the year for outstanding service or duties above and beyond that normally expected of a good firefighter. A specific act(s) performed in rescuing life and/or protecting property above and beyond the call of duty.

Any member of MSFA or a member of a fire department or county association which is a member of the Michigan State Firemen's Association. Members of the executive board of the Michigan State Firemen's Association are excluded.

Entry for the Heroes Award shall be submitted by his or her fire department, county association, and/or concerned citizen.

Entry shall be submitted with supporting documents attached, such as certificates, photos, letters, citations, news articles and any other additional documents.

Judging will be by a committee appointed by the President of the Michigan State Firemen's Association.

Any member of MSFA or member of a fire department or county association that is a member of the Michigan State Firemen's Association. Members of the executive board of the Michigan State Firemen's Association are excluded.

Entry for the Public Service Award for year shall be submitted by his or her fire department, county association, and/or concerned citizen.

Entry shall be submitted with supporting documents attached, such as certificates, photos, letters, citations, news articles and any other additional documents.
